EITHER

B. You need to respond to an email in which your Chilean penfriend has asked you to tell him/her about your island. Write an email of about **100 words**, in **SPANISH**, providing your penfriend with the following information:

- A description of your island
- Different things tourists can do
- A place of interest on your island and what you like about it
- An event that took place recently
- When you are going to visit another island and why
